

AB on the fiber optic patch cord

Article Overview

"AB" on a fiber optic patch cord indicates the A-B polarity, ensuring that the transmit (Tx) signal on one end connects to the receive (Rx) port on the other, maintaining proper bidirectional communication.

What A-B Polarity Means

In duplex fiber optic systems, two fibers are used: one for transmitting data and one for receiving. A-B polarity ensures that the Tx on one device connects to the Rx on the other device, preventing communication errors caused by connecting Tx to Tx or Rx to Rx . A duplex patch cord labeled "A-B" is typically a straight-through connection, meaning the fiber positions are arranged so that the B fiber on one end connects to the A fiber on the other end .

How It Works

- **Connector Orientation:** Duplex connectors like LC or SC have a key that prevents rotation, ensuring the fibers maintain their correct positions.
- **Fiber Mapping:** In an A-B patch cord, one fiber runs from position A on one end to position B on the other, and the second fiber runs from B to A. This crossover maintains proper polarity and bidirectional data flow .
- **Installation Consistency:** Following A-B polarity standards, as defined in TIA-568-C.0 and TIA-568.3-E, ensures that all patch panels, adapters, and transceivers are correctly aligned, even across multiple cable segments .
