Jumper Cables (Fiber Patch Cords)

Fiber optic jumper cables, also known as patch cords, are short cables with connectors on both ends. Jumpers typically have a thicker protective layer to withstand handling and are ideal for connecting equipment to fiber optic cabling links in a network environment . Common connector types include LC, SC, ST, and FC, and they are available in single-mode or multi-mode variants .

Pigtails

A fiber optic pigtail is a short cable with a pre-terminated connector on one end, while the other end is left unterminated or stripped for splicing. Pigtails are primarily used at splicing and termination points, such as in distribution frames or telecommunication cabinets, to connect longer trunk cables to network equipment. The exposed end is fused to another fiber using a fusion splicer, creating a continuous optical path . Pigtails are often sold in standard lengths and can be cut to fit installation requirements.
