Yes, galvanized cable trays should be mechanically connected for stability and may require grounding or bonding depending on their use and local electrical codes.

Mechanical Connection

Galvanized cable trays must be physically connected to ensure system stability, support the weight of cables, and prevent sagging or misalignment. Proper connections improve durability, facilitate maintenance, and comply with building and electrical codes. Common connection methods include splice plates, bolted connections, clamps, and quick-connect systems, which secure tray sections in straight runs or at junctions, maintaining structural integrity and load-bearing capacity .

Electrical Grounding and Bonding

Even if galvanized, metallic cable trays are considered exposed conductive parts and may need to be grounded. According to NEC Article 250.96, all metallic trays must be grounded regardless of whether they serve as an equipment grounding conductor (EGC). The tray itself can sometimes act as the EGC if its cross-section and continuity meet code requirements, but installing a separate EGC conductor bonded to each or alternate tray section is a recommended practice for safety .
