

Cable tray installation length requirements

Article Overview

Cable trays should be installed with supports spaced typically between 1.5 to 3 meters, with tray sections aligned, level, and properly secured to prevent sagging and ensure safety.

Support Spacing and Tray Length

The length of a cable tray run is determined primarily by the type of tray, the load it carries, and the support spacing. Standard practice is to space supports every 1.5 to 3 meters for most ladder or ventilated trays, depending on the weight and type of cables installed . For example, a 6-meter tray section would typically have supports placed approximately 1.5 meters from each end if using two support points . This ensures the tray remains level and prevents sagging under the weight of cables.

Installation Considerations

- **Alignment and Leveling:** Trays should be installed straight and level, with connectors and fittings properly secured to maintain structural integrity .
- **Cable Management:** Leave enough slack for thermal expansion, movement, or future adjustments. Organize cables by voltage and function using ties or straps .
- **Grounding and Bonding:** Metal trays must be electrically continuous and bonded across sections to serve as a safe grounding path .
- **Drainage and Moisture:** For uncovered trays, slight elevation at one end may be necessary to allow water drainage
