- **Tray Selection:** Depending on cable type, weight, and ventilation needs, trays can be ladder-type, perforated, solid-bottom, or wire mesh . Ladder trays are often preferred for heavy power cables, while perforated or wire mesh trays are suitable for lighter instrumentation or control cables.
- **Support and Alignment:** Trays inside trenches are supported using brackets, channel supports, or floor stands at regular intervals (typically 1.5–2 meters) to mai...
