Prohibited Areas: Cable trays cannot be used in hoistways or enclosed spaces and must remain accessible. **Fill Limits:** For power cables, the fill must not exceed 40% of the tray's. ER cable is allowed to leave the cable tray for distances up to six feet, as long as it is supported and secured. In many cases there is more than one type of cable for a particular application, for instance both cables rated as tray cable (TC) and cables rated as metal clad (MC) can be used for.
