Hardwired (Corrugated Conduit) Systems

Hardwired systems use physical cables routed through conduits to connect sensors and devices to a central monitoring system. They are traditionally considered reliable for deterministic or real-time control applications, such as high-speed measurements or integration with control platforms like NI CompactDAQ or CompactRIO .

Advantages:

- High reliability and deterministic communication
- Suitable for high-frequency data acquisition
- Direct integration with control systems
- High installation cost due to conduit, cabling, and labor
- Time-consuming deployment, often requiring scaffolding or trenching
- Vulnerable to environmental hazards (mud, water, ash, rugged terrain)
- Less flexible for retrofitting or expanding monitoring points
