This enhances scalability and reliability in large networks. 4. **High-Speed Packet Forwarding** These switches use ASIC-based hardware acceleration to forward packets at wire speed, minimizing latency and maximizing throughput. Methods like cut-through switching or packet-by-packet Layer 3 switching ensure efficient handling of both intra- and inter-subnet traffic . 5. **VLAN Segmentation and Broadcast Control** Layer 3 switches can segment networks into multiple VLANs, creating separate broadcast domains and improving network security and performance . They also allow VLAN trunking and aggregation for high-bandwidth connections. 6. **Scalability and Port Density** They provide multiple high-speed ports similar to Layer 2 switches but with added routing functionality, su...
