

Distance between cable tray cover plates



Article Overview

Cable tray cover plates should be supported at intervals that maintain structural integrity, prevent sagging, and allow proper ventilation, typically every 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load.

Recommended Support and Cover Spacing

- **Support Span:** For horizontal cable tray runs, the typical support span between supports ranges from 1.5 meters to 3 meters, which ensures stability and allows for maintenance access. Longer spans may require additional support or stronger tray materials to prevent sagging .
- **Vertical Clearance:** When stacking trays or installing multiple layers, maintain a minimum vertical clearance of 150 mm between trays to allow airflow, heat dissipation, and future cable additions .
- **Cover Plate Placement:** Solid or ventilated cover plates should be installed so that the distance between supports does not exceed the tray's rated span, often aligning with the support intervals. For short-span trays, supports are typically every 1.8 to 2.4 meters (6-8 feet), while intermediate spans may be 3-3.6 meters (10-12 feet) , .
- **Splice Plates:** Only one splice plate should be placed between support spans to maintain structural integrity. The cover plate should align with these splice points to ensure proper load distribution .

Additional Considerations

- **Cable Type and Load:** Heavier cables or high-density installations may require shorter support intervals to prevent deflection of the cover plate....
