

Distance between cable trays laid in parallel

The minimum recommended distance between two parallel cable trays at the same height is 0.6 meters to ensure safety, maintenance access, and proper heat dissipation.

Standard Parallel Spacing

When installing cable trays in parallel at the same elevation, a minimum horizontal distance of 0.6 meters is recommended. This spacing allows technicians to perform inspections, maintenance, and cable replacement safely while ensuring adequate airflow to prevent overheating of the cables .

Power and Signal Cable Tray Separation

For installations where power and signal cable trays run parallel, a minimum spacing of 0.5 meters is advised to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI) and maintain signal integrity . If the trays are shielded, this distance can be reduced to less than 0.3 meters, as shielding helps contain EMI within the tray .

Vertical Spacing Considerations

For floor-mounted or stacked cable trays, a minimum vertical clearance of 150 millimeters is recommended. This ensures structural integrity, allows for future expansion, and facilitates proper ventilation and cooling
