Common Causes

1. Insulation Aging or Breakdown Even without load, insulation on wires or components can degrade over time due to heat, moisture, or UV exposure. This can lead to short circuits or arcing inside the box, causing ignition . 2. Loose or Improper Connections Loose terminals, improperly installed DIN clasps, or wires pinched under insulation can create high-resistance points. These points generate heat even under minimal or no load, potentially igniting surrounding materials . 3. High Ambient Temperature Outdoor distribution boxes exposed to direct sunlight or heat-reflective surfaces can exceed safe operating temperatures. Internal components like fuses, breakers, or coils may overheat, accelerating insulation failure and contact burning . 4. Component Defects Faulty breakers, surge protectors, or contactors can malfunction and produce sparks or localized heating. Even without load, defective components may trigger ignition . 5. Moisture or Contaminants Water ingress, dust, or corrosion can create unintended conductive paths, leading to arcing or short circuits inside the box .

Troubleshooting Steps

- Visual Inspection: Check for discoloration, burn marks, or melted insulation. Inspect all wiring, terminals, and components for damage .
- Tighten Connections: Ensure all screws, DIN terminal clasps, and busbar connections are secure. Loose connections are a common cause of heating
