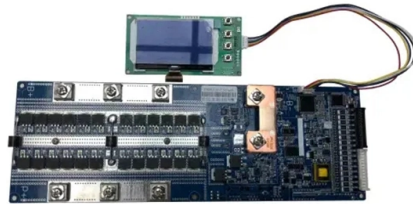


Enclosure of Level 3 Distribution Box

A Level 3 distribution box enclosure is a robust, modular housing designed for high-current, low-voltage distribution, offering protection, accessibility, and compliance with IEC and local standards.

Key Features

Material and Construction: Level 3 distribution enclosures are typically made from high-strength ABS, polycarbonate, aluminium, or sheet steel, providing impact resistance, corrosion protection, and durability for indoor or outdoor use (IP65-IP66) depending on environmental requirements . Some enclosures include conductive coatings for EMC shielding and polished finishes for tamper-proof applications .

Protection Rating: Enclosures are rated according to IP (Ingress Protection) standards, commonly IP65 or IP66, ensuring protection against dust, water jets, and harsh environmental conditions . This is critical for maintaining safety and reliability in industrial or commercial installations.

Internal Layout and Modularity: Level 3 enclosures are designed to accommodate busbars, MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, isolators, surge protective devices, and neutral/earth bars. They often feature DIN rail mounting, removable panels, and modular compartments to allow easy installation, maintenance, and future expansion . Some systems, like Legrand XL3 cabinets, provide withdrawable units for service continuity and flexible phase balancing .

Mounting and Access: Enclosures can be wall-mounted or floor-standing, with hinged doors, key latches, or quick-release catches for secure and convenient access . Cable entry is facilitated through knockouts or gland plates, and some designs allow top and bottom extensions for additional wiring space.
