Understanding IP65

The IP65 rating is defined by the IEC 60529 standard, which classifies the degree of protection an enclosure provides against solid objects and liquids . The code consists of two digits:

- First digit (6): Indicates protection against solid particles. A “6” means the enclosure is dust-tight, preventing any ingress of dust that could interfere with operation or safety .
- Second digit (5): Indicates protection against liquids. A “5” means the enclosure can withstand low-pressure water jets from any direction without harmful effects . This does not include immersion; for that, higher ratings like IP67 or IP68 are required.

How Industrial Switches Achieve IP65

- Sealed Enclosures: The switch housing is designed with tight-fitting covers and gaskets, often made from silicone, rubber, or other resilient materials, to prevent dust and water ingress .
- Precision Molding and Assembly: Components are manufactured with precise tolerances and assembled under controlled conditions to ensure a perfect seal.
