Step 1: Confirm and Collect Fault Information

Before taking action, verify the fault by checking network performance, signal loss, or intermittent errors. Collect details such as affected fiber type (single-mode or multimode), connector types, and symptoms like high insertion loss or unusual reflectance. If the fault cannot be determined, contact technical support for guidance .

Step 2: Visual Inspection

Perform a visual inspection of the cable and connectors. Look for:

- Contamination on connector ferrules (dust, oil, or lint)
- Physical damage such as bends, kinks, or pinched sections
- Improper routing or tight loops that exceed the cable's bend radius
