A fiber optic circulator is a non-reciprocal, multi-port device that routes light sequentially from one port to the next, with color-coded ports (white, blue, red) typically indicating Port 1, Port 2, and Port 3 for easy identification.

### Function and Operation

A fiber optic circulator is a three- or four-port passive device that ensures light travels in a specific, unidirectional path. For a standard three-port circulator:

- Light entering Port 1 (white) exits Port 2 (blue)
- Light entering Port 2 (blue) exits Port 3 (red)
- Light entering Port 3 (red) is either routed to Port 1 or terminated depending on the design This sequential routing prevents back reflections from returning to the source, protecting sensitive components like lasers, EDFAs, or DWDM modules .

### How It Works

The circulator operates using magneto-optic effects, typically a Faraday rotator combined with polarizers and waveplates. The Faraday effect rotates the polarization of light in a non-reciprocal manner, meaning light traveling backward is diverted to a different port rather than reflecting back . This ensures high isolation between ports and maintains signal integrity.
