

Fire cable tray support spacing 6



Article Overview

For fire-rated cable trays, a typical support spacing is 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) for rungs, with fire-resistant supports required to prevent premature failure in a fire.

Recommended Support Spacing

For wire-mesh or ladder-type cable trays, the rungs should generally be spaced 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) apart to maintain cable stability and prevent sagging, especially for instrumentation and control cables . This spacing ensures that cables are adequately supported while allowing for proper ventilation and heat dissipation.

Fire-Resistant Support Requirements

All supports for fire-rated cable trays must be manufactured from fire-resistant materials to ensure the system remains intact during a fire . This includes using steel, galvanized steel, or other materials that will not fail under high temperatures. Supports should be installed at intervals that prevent undue mechanical strain on the cables and terminations.

Horizontal and Vertical Runs

- Horizontal runs: Apply the standard spacing of 6–9 inches for rungs or supports.
- Vertical runs: For long vertical sections, strain relief measures should be incorporated, such as short horizontal offsets or tension-relieving sections, to prevent excessive stress on the cables .
- Bends and transitions: Supports should be placed on either side of bends, and the...
