Avoid vertical stacks without fire protection, as vertical trays can act like chimneys, spreading fire rapidly . 3. **Fire Protection Measures:** Apply fire-retardant coatings or tapes, such as FLAMMOTECT-A or DG-CR 0.7, to enhance fire resistance and protect cables from heat, flame propagation, and environmental factors like moisture, UV, and chemicals . Fire pillows or sandbag-like barriers can be used around cables during construction to prevent fire spread . 4. **Compliance with Standards:** Follow recognized standards such as NEC Article 392 (U.S.), IEC 61537 (International), and fire performance standards like EN 50200 or BS 476. These standards cover tray sizing, support, separation, load ratings, and fire resistance to ensure safety and regulatory compliance . 5. **Installation Accuracy:** Ensure trays are level, plumb, and securely mounted. Horizontal deviation should not exceed 2 mm per meter, and vertical deviation should not exceed 3 mm per meter. Proper support spacing and mechanical strength are essential to prevent deformation under full cable load . 6. **Grounding and Electrical Safety:** Metal trays must be properly grounded to safely conduct stray electricity. Use quality connection kits with star washers to ensure reliable electrical continuity and prevent shock hazards . 7. **Maintenance and Inspection:** Regularly inspect trays for corrosion, loose connections, or damage to fire-retardant coatings. Maintain adequate spacing between cables to prevent overheating and ensure fire safety .
