Often, fiber enters the structure to a centralized rack or data room where it is connected to a modem. The modem connects to a network switch which connects each remote point (rooms, floors, distributed network switches, etc. The transition splice occurs in a different location from the optical fiber distribution frames to better manage the fiber and cable.
