

How long should the copper wire connected to the cable tray be

Overview

Generally, standard trays require supports every 6 to 10 feet, while heavy-duty, long-span trays can handle distances of up to 20 feet between supports. 10 (B) (1), the smallest size single conductor allowed to be installed in a cable tray is 1/0 AWG. For the installation of single conductor cables sized 1/0 AWG to 4/0 AWG in industrial establishments, the NEC specifies the maximum allowable rung spacing for the cable. Cable tray is a structural support system that carries cables and conductors while leaving them accessible for inspection, heat dissipation, maintenance, and future changes. NEC Article 392 governs cable tray installations, covering tray types, fill. Tray fill limits must be calculated properly. Power and data cables require proper separation.
