The most immediate limit on the number of circuits is the physical design of the panel box, defined by the manufacturer's specifications. A standard 200-amp residential panel typically features 30 to 42 physical slots, also referred to as spaces, where circuit breakers can be. Prior to the 2008 edition of the National Electrical Code (NEC), residential panels were limited to 42 circuits due to concerns about heat generation. This meant that a residential electrical panel could contain no more than 42 overcurrent devices for lighting and appliance branch circuits. Diagrams are like maps for your wires.
