

How many megabits of fiber optic cable should I buy for my router

For a fiber internet connection, your router should support at least the maximum speed of your fiber plan, typically 1 Gbps or higher, with multi-gigabit capability for future-proofing.

Router Speed Requirements

To fully utilize a fiber optic connection, the router must support speeds equal to or greater than your internet plan. For example:

- 1 Gbps fiber: Use a router with Gigabit Ethernet ports (1 Gbps) and Wi-Fi 5 or Wi-Fi 6 standards to achieve near-full speeds over wireless connections .
- Multi-gig fiber (2–10 Gbps): Choose a multi-gig router with 2.5 Gbps or 10 Gbps WAN/LAN ports and Wi-Fi 6E or Wi-Fi 7 for high-speed wireless performance .

Wi-Fi Considerations

Even if your fiber plan is very fast, Wi-Fi speeds are affected by:

- Router standard: Wi-Fi 6 can reach up to 9.6 Gbps theoretically, while Wi-Fi 5 tops out around 3.5 Gbps .
- Distance and obstacles: Walls, floors, and furniture reduce effective speeds.
- Number of devices: Bandwidth is shared; more devices reduce per-device speed....
