Basic Requirement

Multimode optical cables are usually used for short-distance, high-speed connections, such as within buildings or data centers . Each link requires two optical transceivers (modules): one to convert electrical signals to optical signals at the transmitting end, and one to convert optical signals back to electrical signals at the receiving end . This is true for duplex connections, which are the most common setup for multimode fiber, where one fiber carries the transmit signal and the other carries the receive signal .
