

How many tubes and cores does a 48c optical cable have

Article Overview

A standard 48-core optical fiber cable typically has 6 loose tubes, each containing 8 fibers, totaling 48 cores.

Cable Structure

Most 48-core outdoor fiber optic cables use a loose-tube design for flexibility and protection:

- Number of tubes: 6 loose tubes arranged around a central strength member (6-around-1 configuration) .
- Fibers per tube: Each tube contains 8 fibers, giving a total of 48 cores (6 tubes × 8 fibers) .
- Fiber types: Can be single-mode (G.652D or G.657A1) or multimode (OM3/OM4), depending on the application .
- Tube filling: Tubes are often jelly-filled or gel-filled to prevent water ingress, with dry-blocking materials between tubes for additional moisture protection .

Protective Features

- Armor: Many 48-core cables include corrugated steel tape (CST) armor for rodent and mechanical protection .
- Outer jacket: Polyethylene (PE) or UV-stabilized PE jackets are common for outdoor durability and direct burial suitability ...
