

How thick should hot-dip galvanized cable trays be

Hot-dip galvanized cable trays typically have a zinc coating thickness of 65 to 85 microns, providing long-term corrosion protection.

Hot-dip galvanizing involves immersing the steel tray into molten zinc, which coats every surface, including corners, holes, and edges, forming a robust protective layer. This coating is significantly thicker than pre-galvanized or zinc-coated trays, which usually have a thinner layer of 12 to 20 microns and are more suitable for indoor or low-moisture environments. The thick zinc layer of 65–85 microns ensures resistance to rain, salt air, and harsh industrial conditions, often lasting over 20 years.

- **Corrosion Resistance:** The thick zinc layer prevents rust and degradation even in outdoor or chemical-exposed environments.
- **Durability:** Hot-dip galvanized trays maintain structural integrity under heavy cable loads and harsh conditions.
- **Longevity:** The coating reduces maintenance needs and extends the service life of the cable tray system.
