

How to connect a pigtail to the main optical cable

Article Overview

Fiber optic pigtails are connected to optical cables primarily through fusion splicing, creating a low-loss, permanent joint between the bare fiber end of the pigtail and the incoming cable.

Overview of Pigtail Connections

A fiber optic pigtail is a short fiber with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other. The bare end is designed to be permanently joined to the optical cable, while the connector end plugs into equipment, an Optical Distribution Frame (ODF), or a patch panel . This method ensures high precision and minimal signal loss compared to field-terminated connectors.

Fusion Splicing

Fusion splicing is the most common and recommended method for connecting a pigtail to an optical cable:

- The bare fiber of the pigtail is aligned with the stripped fiber from the optical cable using a fusion splicer.
- The splicer uses an electric arc to melt and fuse the two fibers together, forming a continuous optical path.
- This method provides low insertion loss, low back reflection, and high reliability, making it ideal for data centers, FTTH deployments, and long-distance links
