Understanding Leather Fibers

Leather is composed of interwoven collagen fibers forming a three-dimensional matrix that gives it strength, flexibility, and durability . The grain layer contains dense, tightly packed fibers for abrasion resistance, while the corium layer has looser fibers for flexibility and shock absorption . Aging, improper cleaning, or lack of conditioning can cause fiber collapse, stiffness, or surface cracking . Tail fibers, often referring to the ends of leather strands or edges, are particularly vulnerable to wear and require careful handling.

Cleaning Leather Fibers

- **Dust Regularly:** Use a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and debris from the surface .
- **Spot Cleaning:** For soluble stains (tea, coffee, milk), dab gently with a white, non-abrasive cloth and dry immediately . For grease stains, use absorbent paper first, then a lightly dampened cloth with a mild natural detergent .
- **Avoid Excess Water:** Never soak leather or use a hairdryer on wet areas, as this can damage fibers .
- **Use Appropriate Cleaners:** Select cleaners formulated for the specific type of leather (natural, bonded, or faux) to avoid stripping oils or damaging the fiber structure
