Key Specifications

1. Split Ratio The split ratio indicates how the input optical signal is divided among the output fibers. For example, a 1×4 splitter takes one input and distributes it to four outputs, while a 1×32 splitter distributes to 32 outputs. Higher split ratios allow more users to share a single fiber but increase signal attenuation, limiting network reach . 2. Insertion Loss Insertion loss measures the reduction in signal power caused by the splitting process. It is expressed in decibels (dB) and increases with higher split ratios. For instance, a 1×2 splitter has lower insertion loss than a 1×32 splitter. Minimizing insertion loss is critical to maintain signal quality over long distances . 3. Uniformity Uniformity describes how evenly the optical power is distributed across all output ports. High uniformity ensures that each output receives nearly the same signal strength, which is essential for consistent performance in networks like FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home), . 4. Type of Splitter

- FBT (Fused Biconical Taper) Splitters: Made by fusing and tapering fibers together. They are cost-effective for small split configurations (1×2, 1×4) but less precise for larger splits .
- PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) Splitters: Use integrated waveguides on a quartz substrate to evenly distribute light. PLC splitters are ideal for larger splits (1×16, 1...
