

How to mark the wire number when laying optical cables

Mark optical cables using a consistent alphanumeric ID system, durable printed labels, and clear placement at both ends and along the cable route.

Assigning Cable IDs

Each optical cable should have a unique identifier that distinguishes it from other cables in the facility. Use a logical alphanumeric format that reflects the cable's location, type, and sequence. For example, "FB-03-A142" could indicate fiber (FB), floor or zone (03), and the specific cable number (A142) . Abbreviations can also denote departments, wings, or panels, such as "C" for cable or "A/B" for different zones . Ensure the numbering system aligns with your system drawings to maintain consistency.

Label Placement

- Both ends of the cable: Clearly indicate the source and destination, e.g., "Server Rack 12A to IDF-3" .
- Along the cable route: For long runs, place labels at intervals or at junction points to facilitate identification during maintenance .
- Panel terminations: Label individual fibers or bundles minimally but clearly, using abbreviations and numbers to indicate the connection, e.g., "AB05-14:01" for cabinet AB05, panel 14, port 01 .

Label Materials and Methods

- Printed labels are preferred over handwritten ones for clarity and durability .
- Thermal-printed labels resist fading, temperature changes, and handling, lasting over 10 years .
- Heat-shrink tubing labels are ideal for outdoor or harsh environments, adhering permanently and resisting UV exposure and scratching .
- Self-laminating labels can be used indoors but should be applied perpendicular to the cable to avoid damage when bending .
