

Indoor distribution box reserved height

Overview

The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience. This height also safeguards the box from potential. This is referred to as the side-to-side working space. At no point can this be less than the height of the equipment. Dedicated equipment space is the space equal to the width and depth of the equipment (the envelope of the equipment), extending from the floor to a height of 6 feet above the equipment or to the structural ceiling, whichever is. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1.
