

Inspecting optical cable line loss

Overview

Visual inspection identifies contamination, scratches, cracks, and endface defects that directly affect optical performance. This measurement is the basis for loss measurements as well as the power from a source or presented at a receiver. Power Meter Testing simulates the way the cable will function with an actual link.
