

Installation height of construction site electrical distribution box

Article Overview

The recommended installation height for a construction site electrical distribution box is typically between 1.4 and 1.8 meters (4.5 to 5.9 feet) above the ground.

Recommended Height

For wall-mounted distribution boxes, the bottom edge should generally be 1.5 to 1.8 meters above the floor to allow easy access for operation and inspection without excessive bending or stretching, while keeping the box safe from water spills or accidental impacts . Outdoor boxes should be installed at least 3 feet (≈ 0.9 meters) above ground to protect against water and dirt . Ground-mounted boxes should be slightly elevated, typically 2 to 4 inches, to prevent moisture damage .

Compliance and Safety Considerations

- **Standards:** Installation heights follow standards such as BS 7671, IEC 60364-5-52, and NEC 404.8, which specify accessibility and workspace requirements . NEC guidelines recommend that panelboards should not exceed 2 meters (6 ft 7 in) above the floor for safe operation .
- **Clearance:** Maintain a minimum clearance of 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high in front of the box to allow safe access and full door opening .
- **Grounding:** All metal parts, including the box and internal components, must be properly grounded. A protective neutral wire and leakage protector should be installed for additional safety
