

Installation of Gas Protection for Distribution Boxes

To install gas protection in a distribution box, use an explosion-proof (Ex d) enclosure with certified components, proper cable glands, and follow strict wiring and safety standards.

Choosing the Right Enclosure

Select a flameproof or gas-protected distribution box certified for hazardous areas (Ex d, Ex e, or Ex i) according to ATEX, IECEx, or local standards . Materials like copper-free aluminum or stainless steel provide corrosion resistance, impact strength, and long-term durability in harsh environments . Ensure the enclosure is rated for the zone classification of your site (e.g., Zone 1 or Zone 2 for gas) and has an appropriate IP rating (IP66 or higher) to prevent gas ingress .

Wiring and Component Selection

- **Power Off:** Always isolate the circuit at the main supply before installation to prevent electrical hazards .
- **Certified Components:** Use EX or ATEX-certified cables, connectors, and terminal blocks suitable for hazardous areas .
- **Terminal Blocks:** Connect power and signal cables to the provided terminal blocks inside the enclosure .
- **Cable Glands:** Use barrier glands for gas zones to seal each conductor individually, preventing gas migration along the cable . Ensure the gland is torqued correctly and matches the cable diameter. Unused entries must be sealed with certified blanking...
