

Is OM4 fiber optic cable backward compatible with OM3

Overview

For OM3 and OM4 compatibility, OM4 fiber is completely backwards compatible with OM3 fiber since they have the same core diameter. However, when connecting two products with different performance levels the best performance that can be expected will be that of the lower performing. OM3 fiber and OM4 fiber are both laser-optimized multimode fibers with 50/125µm fiber cores, which need to meet the ISO 11801 standard.
