**Fiber Optic Cable:** A fiber optic cable is the medium that carries light signals over distances. It consists of bare fibers (core + cladding + coating) protected by jackets, strength members, and sometimes armor for indoor, outdoor, or specialized applications. These cables are designed for routing signals across long distances and protecting the fiber from environmental stress, UV, water, and mechanical damage .

**Optical Patch Cord (Fiber Optic Patch Cord):** A patch cord, also called a fiber jumper, is a short-length fiber optic cable with connectors on both ends. Its primary purpose is to interconnect devices such as transceivers, patch panels, and distribution boxes. Patch cords are used for flexible, reconfigurable connections rather than permanent splicing. They can be simplex (single fiber) or duplex (two fibers) and come in single-mode or multimode variants .

**Relationship:** While a patch cord contains fiber optic cable inside, it is specifically terminated with connectors for easy plug-and-play use. In contrast, standard fiber optic cables are not pre-terminated and require splicing or connectorization to interface with equipment. Patch cords are essentially a ready-to-use segment of fiber optic cable designed for front-end connectivity, not for long-haul routing .
