

Is it okay to connect a fiber optic cable to a pigtail

Why Pigtails Are Used

A fiber optic pigtail is a short fiber with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other, designed to be permanently spliced to the incoming fiber cable in the field . This approach ensures low insertion loss, high return loss, and consistent performance, because the delicate connector polishing is done in a controlled factory environment rather than in the field .

Risks of Direct Connection

Connecting a fiber cable directly to a pigtail without proper fusion or mechanical splicing can lead to:

- Elevated signal loss: Misalignment or poor contact between fibers increases attenuation, reducing the efficiency of data transmission .
- Increased back reflection: Improper connections can reflect light back into the source, potentially interfering with sensitive equipment .
- Reduced long-term reliability: Bare fiber is extremely fragile; direct connections without protective splicing are prone to micro-bending, mechanical stress, and environmental damage
