

Is the indoor distribution box grounded

Article Overview

Yes, indoor distribution boxes must be properly grounded to ensure safety, equipment protection, and system stability.

Importance of Grounding

Grounding an indoor distribution box provides a low-impedance path for fault currents, reducing the risk of electric shock to personnel and protecting equipment from surges, lightning strikes, and transient overvoltages . It also stabilizes voltage levels within the electrical system and ensures that protective devices like circuit breakers operate correctly .

Grounding Requirements

Each distribution box and controller must be grounded. In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is typically used, while in other markets a 6 mm² wire is standard . The grounding system should connect the box to a dedicated ground bar, which is then connected to the central grounding point of the facility. The total ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 ohm to ensure effective fault current dissipation .

Grounding Procedure

- Inspect the box: Ensure the distribution box is intact and free of cracks or damage before grounding .
- Install a ground wire: Connect one end to a metal part of the box or a threaded stud and the other end to a grounding rod or mounting plate
