

Is there a quota for fiber optic cable pullback

Yes, fiber optic cable pullback is limited by maximum tension, bend radius, and conduit fill, rather than a fixed "quota" of length.

Maximum Pulling Tension

Fiber optic cables have a maximum pulling tension specified by the manufacturer to prevent fiber breakage. Exceeding this tension can damage the glass fibers inside the cable, reducing performance or causing failure. Installers should calculate the expected tension using factors such as straight drag, vertical lift, bends, and method factors, and compare it to the cable's rated maximum tension before starting the pull .

Bend Radius and Conduit Considerations

The minimum bend radius is critical during pullback. Tight bends increase sidewall pressure and can crush the cable. Conduit fill ratio, number of bends, and conduit diameter all affect the safe pull distance. Maintaining proper bend radius and using lubricants can reduce friction and prevent damage .

Pullback Distance

There is no universal "quota" in terms of distance; instead, the maximum pull length is determined by the cable type, installation method, and route conditions. For long...
