A protective relay is an automatic device that monitors electrical quantities such as current, voltage, or impedance and sends a trip signal to a circuit breaker when abnormal conditions occur, such as short circuits or overloads, to prevent equipment damage and maintain system stability. Relays do not interrupt current directly; they act as decision-making devices, while breakers perform the physical disconnection.

Understanding IX Relay

The designation "IX" is often used in relay documentation or schematics to indicate a specific type of current-based protection. In many cases, "I" refers to current, and "X" may denote a particular phase, auxiliary function, or a differential protection scheme. For example, differential relays (ANSI device 87) compare the current entering and leaving a protected zone and trip the breaker if an imbalance is detected. This ensures fast and sensitive fault detection, minimizing equipment damage.
