

Method for Calculating the Length of Fiber Optic Pigtails

1. Determine Equipment Connection Requirements Identify all devices that require pigtail connections, such as optical modules, ODF panels, or terminals. Each device typically needs at least one pair of pigtails (transmit and receive) based on the network design and equipment list . 2. Measure Physical Distance and Routing Path

- Straight-line distance: Measure the direct distance between the devices.
- Routing path: Account for the actual path the fiber will take, including bends, conduits, bridges, or obstacles. This ensures the pigtail is long enough to follow the installation route without tension . 3. Consider Bending Radius Ensure the pigtail meets the minimum bending radius to prevent signal loss or fiber damage. Typically, multimode fibers require a minimum radius of 30mm, while single-mode fibers require about 10mm . 4. Add Reserved Length Include extra fiber at both ends for device interface, fixation, jumpering, and future adjustments. This reserved length allows technicians to handle the fiber safely and make modifications if needed . 5. Include Safety and Redundancy Add a safety margin, usually 10–20% of the calculated length, to accommodate future network expansion or unexpected adjustments . 6.
