Optical path assembly in modules involves precise alignment of optical sub-assemblies using adhesives, support blocks, and guide pins to ensure micron-level accuracy and long-term reliability.

Overview of Optical Module Assembly

Optical modules rely on optical sub-assemblies (OSA) such as TOSA (Transmitting Optical Sub-Assembly), ROSA (Receiving Optical Sub-Assembly), and BOSA (Bi-Directional Optical Sub-Assembly) to convert electrical signals to optical signals and vice versa, and to guide light through fibers with minimal loss . The assembly process must maintain micron-level alignment, prevent contamination, and accommodate differences in material thermal expansion .

Key Steps in Optical Path Assembly

- **Preparation of Optical Connector and Base** The optical connector includes a base with an optical waveguide and a support block holding the optical fiber. The base has defined end surfaces for alignment with the optical device .
- **Alignment to Optical Device** The first support block is temporarily fixed to the base, and the base is aligned to the optical device. This ensures the optical fiber is precisely positioned relative to the device .
- **Fixing and Replacing Support Blocks** After alignment, the base is permanently fixed to the optical device. The first support block is removed, and a second support block is re-attached, often using guide pins to ensure accurate positioning .
- **Bonding and Adhesive Application** Adhesives, particularly UV-curable adhesives, are commonly used to bond optical components. These adhesives allow precise alignm...
