Purpose of Testing NRZ AOCs

NRZ AOCs integrate optical fibers and transceivers in a single assembly, making them susceptible to electronic and optical failures. Testing ensures that the cable meets its rated speed, maintains low latency, and operates reliably under load. Key objectives include verifying link establishment at intended data rates (e.g., 25G, 50G, 100G per lane), detecting optical contamination or connector damage, and confirming compatibility with switches, servers, or NICs .

Test Methodology

Testing NRZ AOCs typically involves two main steps:

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Input Calibration Step: A stress signal is generated according to the cable's input electrical specifications. For example, in 56G-IB-FDR AOCs, four 14-Gbps parallel lanes are tested using a signal quality analyzer to ensure the input meets InfiniBand standards .

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Output Measurement Step: The stress signal is applied to the cable, and the output is measured for signal integrity, eye diagram compliance, and error rates. This step co...
