North Korea's main connection to the international Internet is through a fiber-optic cable connecting Pyongyang with Dandong, China, crossing the China–North Korea border at Sinuiju. Internet access is provided by China Unicom. North Korea's pursuit of fiber optic cables reflects its struggle with connectivity and modernization, revealing complexities in information control and international dynamics.
