

Notice of Network Interruption for Telecom Fiber Optic Cable Grounding

Article Overview

Network interruptions may occur when grounding or interrupting metallic members in fiber optic cables, as required by NEC and industry standards to ensure safety and system integrity.

Grounding Requirements for Fiber Optic Cables

Fiber optic cables often contain non-current-carrying metallic members that may require grounding if exposed to contact with power conductors. According to NEC 770.93, these metallic members must either be grounded or interrupted by an insulating joint near the point of building entry or termination to prevent electrical hazards and ensure compliance with safety codes (NEC 2014) . Grounding is only mandatory when the metallic members are exposed to potential contact with electrical power; otherwise, an insulating joint can eliminate the need for grounding .

Industry Standards and Best Practices

For commercial and federal buildings, grounding and bonding practices are guided by ANSI/TIA/EIA-607 and related standards, which specify a uniform telecommunications grounding infrastructure. This includes grounding cable shields, metallic pathways, and equipment to a Telecommunications Grounding Busbar (TGB) in the telecommunications room . Proper bonding ensures that electromagnetic interference (EMI) is safely conducted to ground, protecting data integrity and minimizing noise in network systems
