Optical modules at both ends of a fiber optic cable convert electrical signals to optical signals and back, enabling high-speed communication between devices.

Function of Optical Modules

Optical modules, also known as optical transceivers, are essential components in fiber optic communication. At the transmitting end, the module converts electrical signals from a device into optical signals using a laser or LED. These optical signals travel through the fiber optic cable and are then converted back into electrical signals at the receiving end by the module, allowing seamless data transmission between devices ().

Active Optical Cables (AOCs)

An Active Optical Cable (AOC) integrates optical modules directly into the ends of a fiber optic cable. Each end contains a transceiver module that performs photoelectric conversion: electrical signals are converted to light for transmission, and light is converted back to electrical signals at the other end (). AOCs are typically plug-and-play, with fixed connectors and a specified cable length, making them convenient for high-speed interconnects in data centers, storage networks, and high-performance computing environments ().
