While optical modules can perform basic signal conversion without MCUs, modern high-speed modules rely on MCUs for monitoring, control, and management functions.

Role of MCUs in Optical Modules

Optical modules convert electrical signals into optical signals and vice versa, enabling high-speed data transmission. While the core electro-optical conversion can be handled by components such as drivers, TIAs, DSPs, and CDR chips, MCUs are not part of the main data path but serve as intelligent management controllers. Their functions include:

- **Monitoring:** Reading internal parameters like temperature, voltage, laser bias current, and transmit/receive optical power, then reporting these to the host system for diagnostics and predictive maintenance.
- **Control:** Managing laser enablement, shutdown, reset, low-power modes, and power sequencing, often using analog peripherals such as ADCs, DACs, comparators, and operational amplifiers.
- **Protocol Management:** Implementing communication standards (e.g., SFF-8472, SFF-8636, CMIS) to ensure interoperability with host systems.
- **Firmware Management:** Supporting secure boot, dual-bank recovery, firmware upgrades, and module authentication, which are critical for continuous operation in AI data centers.
