

Principle of Manual Optical Cable Mounting Machine

Article Overview

A manual optical cable mounting machine operates by controlling the tension and direction of the cable during installation, using mechanical pulling, swivels, and grips to prevent fiber damage.

Basic Principle

- **Pulling Capstan or Drum:** The cable is fed over a rotating drum or capstan, which provides the pulling force. The operator can manually control the speed and direction of the pull.
- **Swivel Pulling Eyes:** These are attached to the cable's strength members to prevent twisting during installation, ensuring the optical fibers remain undamaged.
- **Cable Mesh Pulling Grips:** These grips distribute the tensile load evenly along the cable jacket or strength member, reducing stress on the fibers.
- **Load Monitoring:** Some manual machines incorporate a load-sensing mechanism or electronic load cell to measure the actual tension applied, allowing the operator to stay within safe limits.
- **Guides and Rollers:** These help direct the cable along the intended path, reducing friction and preventing sharp bends that could exceed the minimum bending radius.

Operational Steps

- **Route Survey and Preparation:** Inspect the duct or conduit, verify cable length, and ensure pulling ropes or rods are in place.
- **Attachment of Pulling Accessories:** Connect the cable to the pulling grips and swivel eyes, ensuring proper alignment with the machine.
- **Controlled Pulling:** The operator manually rotates the capstan or drum, pulling the cable through the duct while monitoring tension and speed.
- **Slack Management:** Maintain appropriate slack at manholes or junction points to a...
