It involves duplicating critical components or paths so that if a primary link fails due to fiber cuts, equipment malfunction, or human error, traffic can seamlessly switch to a backup path without downtime . This is particularly important in industrial automation, rail transit, smart grids, and enterprise networks where continuous communication is critical .

Common Redundancy Strategies

- Protection Switching: Pre-planned backup paths are reserved and can be activated within milliseconds when a failure occurs. Protocols like ERPS (Ethernet Ring Protection Protocol) enable ring networks to recover in as little as 50 milliseconds .
- Restoration: Dynamically finds alternative paths after a failure, offering flexibility but slower recovery times, often in seconds or minutes .
- Rerouting: Traffic is redirected around failed components using dynamic routing or traffic engineering, providing additional resilience .
