Definition and Role

In electrical power systems, QF is a designation used in schematics and relay protection diagrams to indicate a circuit breaker. This breaker is responsible for disconnecting a feeder, transformer, or other equipment when a fault is detected by protective relays. The QF device works in coordination with relays to ensure selective isolation, minimizing the impact of faults on the rest of the system.

Function in Protection Schemes

- **Fault Isolation:** When a relay detects an overcurrent, short circuit, or earth fault, it sends a trip signal to the QF breaker to open the circuit and isolate the faulted section.
- **Coordination:** QF breakers are coordinated with upstream and downstream protection devices to ensure only the affected section is disconnected, maintaining system stability.
- **Integration with ANSI/IEC Standards:** While ANSI device numbers (like 50/51 for overcurrent) define relay functions, QF represents the physical breaker that executes the trip order.
