

Requirements for Ground Cable Tray Installation

Metallic cable trays must be properly grounded and bonded according to NEC standards, using either the tray itself or an equipment grounding conductor (EGC) to ensure electrical safety and system reliability.

NEC Requirements for Grounding Cable Trays

The National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 392 governs cable tray systems, including grounding and bonding requirements. All metallic cable trays must be grounded regardless of whether they are used as an EGC. Grounding ensures that any fault current is safely conducted to the earth, reducing the risk of electric shock or fire (NEC Article 250.96) .

Using Cable Trays as Equipment Grounding Conductors

Metallic trays can serve as the equipment grounding conductor (EGC) in qualifying facilities where only qualified personnel service the system. The tray must be electrically continuous and properly bonded at joints to maintain a low-impedance path for fault currents (NEC Sections 318-3(c) and 250-51) . If an EGC cable is installed alongside the tray, it should be bonded to each or alternate tray sections using grounding clamps to prevent mechanical displacement during fault conditions .
