

Requirements for installing cable tray support arms

Overview

The primary rulebook used in the safe use of cable trays is NEC Article 392. This is a description of how to select, install, and support these metal or plastic frames, on which electrical wires are installed. This guide covers the critical steps, from selecting the right electrical cable tray and performing accurate cable fill. When completely installed, without damage either to conductors or structural system use maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is bent the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. You should consider it as a series of instructions that make the buildings resistant to. This publication is intended as a practical guide for the proper and safe* installation of cable ladder systems, cable tray systems, channel support systems and associated supports. The NEC requires that cable trays must be supported by members at an interval specified by the cable tray manufacturer, but not more than 5 feet for horizontal runs to support the weight of the cables and other loads.
